

## **SECTION D - TRADING DEBTS**

- (a) Yes, it is common for suppliers to supply on credit.
- (b) Although this would depend on a number of factors such as creditworthiness, course of dealing, etc., generally the credit period is approximately 60 to 90 days.
- (c) Although it is possible, suppliers do not ordinarily request security over the corporation's property.
- (d) The concept similar to "retention of title" exists. However, it is not commonly used.
