

## **SECTION D – TRADING DEBTS**

- (a) It is usual for suppliers of goods in Malaysia to supply goods or services to corporations on credit.
- (b) The average credit period is approximately 45 days.
- (c) It would not be inaccurate to say that it is not usual for a supplier to require security over property of a company for the supply of goods or services.
- (d) Some suppliers however do include a retention of title clause in their contracts of supply of goods. The concept of “retention of title” is recognised and practiced in Malaysia.
